The Chatham Area Business and Arts (CABA), a coalition of individuals, businesses and organizations, works to promote the Chatham, New York region as a vibrant, positive environment for shopping, dining, enjoying the arts and conducting business.

CABA is a membership organization governed by a Board of Directors.

CABA Member Benefits:

The Board is responsible for:

- Establishing policies and objectives
- Selecting officers of the Board and reviewing the performance of the board and all those who may be authorized to act on behalf of CABA
- Approving annual CABA budgets
- Informing the members of the organization's performance
- Scheduling and conducting the Annual Meeting of the membership
- Such other tasks as the Board may determine necessary to fulfill the Mission Statement

All Members of the Board must be members of CABA or be acting as the representative of a member of CABA. Only one person affiliated with each member of CABA may serve on the Board at any given time.

Each member of the CABA Board has one vote on measures that come before the Board.

The Board of Directors serve without pay.

Board members serve for one-year terms.

A Board member may not miss 3 consecutive meetings.

Each member of the Board is encouraged to serve on one of CABA's standing committee's: Membership, Marketing, Festivals, and Finance.

The Nominating Committee prepares a slate of nominees for all Board seats to be approved by the current sitting Board and presented to the membership at the annual meeting, or in the event of a vacancy, the current board may fill those seats until the next annual meeting by a majority vote.
